Refund Policy

Please note that all ticket and booking fees are non-refundable. In exceptional cases a request for refund may be considered (eg. illness, injury, family/personal matters) however the request must be made in writing to: enquiries@agcsinc.org.au If a request is made due to illness or injury, a copy of a doctor's/medical certificate must be provided. An administration fee of 25% of the total activity fee (up to a maximum of \$25.00) is non-refundable in all circumstances.

All families are required to support the volunteer coach, and team by assisting with scoring at the games, and/or assisting in any other way that will enhance the Club and players experience. The volunteer team manager will organise a roster and there is an electronic scoring guide

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do we start a basketball team?

Firstly, a parent is required to volunteer as a coach or a team manager. Each team needs 8 players.

2. Where do Giants Basketball Club train?

Currently all teams train at Aspendale Gardens Community Centre based on the volunteer coach availability.

3. How do I register interest in joining a team for next season?

4. What is the level of commitment?

Athletes are required to train for 45 minute plus a 1 hour game.
