

POSITION DESCRIPTION - JUNIOR GIANTS BASKETBALL INSTRUCTOR

Aspendale Gardens Giants Basketball Club was established in 2018 after it was identified as a need in our local community. The Club is overseen by the Aspendale Gardens Community Centre and is part of the Southern Basketball Association.

We currently offer a Junior Giants program that is an introduction to basketball for 5 to 8 year olds. The aim is to develop and learn the basic skills of basketball before joining a competition team.

The Junior Giants program is “term based” and runs for 45 minutes every Monday afternoon 5.30-6.15pm.

In addition to the term program it is expected for the basketball instructor to deliver a 2 hour development session each school holidays. Days and times are negotiable pending court availability.

The Junior Giants coach reports to the Centre Manager/Basketball President however will work with the centre programming staff each week.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop ball handling skills and age-appropriate drills at each training session
- Identify and prepare the children who are ready to join a team the following season.
- Act as a role model by showing the expected court behaviour while encouraging and motivating the children to enjoy the game of basketball.
