

POSITION DESCRIPTION - JUNIOR GIANTS BASKETBALL INSTRUCTOR – PAID ROLE

Aspendale Gardens Giants Basketball Club was established in 2018 after it was identified as a need in our local community. The Club is overseen by the Aspendale Gardens Community Service and is part of the Southern Basketball Association.

We currently offer a Junior Giants program that is an introduction to basketball for 5 to 8 year olds. The aim is to develop and learn the basic skills of basketball before joining a competition team.

The Junior Giants program runs for 45 minutes each term. The successful applicant:

Is required to arrive 15 minutes earlier to set up and 10 minutes after the session to pack up. The instructor can choose a Monday, Wednesday or Friday to run the activity in 2023.

The Junior Giants instructor will report to the Basketball President however will work with the service programming staff each week.

Remuneration : The independent contractors agreement for 2023 is a payment of \$60 per class (including GST).

Capacity: Aspendale Gardens Community Service set a maximum number of 15 participants per class and a minimum requirement of 6 participants to run the term based program.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop ball handling skills and age-appropriate drills at each training session
- Identify and prepare the children who are ready to join a team the following season.
- Act as a role model by showing the expected court behaviour while encouraging and motivating the children to enjoy the game of basketball.

Person Specification

- Extensive basketball knowledge and/or experience playing or coaching basketball.
- Ability to actively support and implement the delivery of a basketball skills training session for a team of young children aged 5 to 8.

- Enjoys working with children
- Positive and supportive

Requirements

- Current Working with Children Check
- Completed Play by the Rules – Child Protection Course
- Level 1 or Level 2 First Aid training

If you do not have your Level 1 or Level 2 First Aid training, Aspendale Gardens Community centre will pay for your enrolment to attend the sessions on Tuesday 21st & 28th March.
